Will the 10 Vol Developer cause more damage to the hair vs a 9 Vol Sync Activator?

The difference between 9 vol to 10 vol is so minimal it is almost negligible.

The 10 volume developer contains 3% hydrogen peroxide, meaning it releases 10 times its volume in oxygen. The 9 volume Sync Activator was 2.7% hydrogen peroxide, so the difference in hydrogen peroxide is only 0.3% and makes very little difference.

If I still want to use a lower volume developer, can I use one from a different company?

No, Matrix SoColor Sync should always be used in guidance with the manufacturer's instructions. SoColor Sync is specifically calibrated to work with Matrix Developers, and these will provide the optimum results.

What is the benefit of moving from the 9 volume Sync Activator to the 10 volume Matrix Developer?

Using anything less than 9 vol with SoColor Sync would not be as effective and could affect the ability to drive the colour into the outer cortex. The catalyst (which is the developer) would not be strong enough, thus effecting the colour result and longevity of SoColor Sync.

Our tests have shown that using a 10 volume Matrix Developer with SoColor Sync results in more clarity of tone, giving further longevity of the toning palette.

Having one developer (10 volume) which can be used for SoColor and SoColour Sync is also much more cost and space effective for stylists.



FAQs

Will the 10 Vol developer kick out more warmth vs the 9 Vol Sync Activator?

We have done extensive tests on all different hair types, levels, greys etc and the results show no more lift versus using the 9 vol SoColor Sync Activator. The SoColor Sync Alkaline range can give you half a level of lift in certain hair types, however this is the same when using the 9 or 10 volume developer.

Will the result be different across the different SoColor Sync technologies?

So Color Sync Acidic: No, in all tests there has been no shift to base levels using the 10 vol Matrix Developer.

So Color Sync Alkaline: Tests have shown no more shift when using the 10 vol Matrix Developer vs the SoColor Sync Activator.

So Color Sync Fast Toners: Tests have shown that when using the Fast toners with 10 vol Matrix Developer, the results are improved as it allows for application time without over depositing.
