

BALAYAGE

FOILYAGE

Foilyage (sometimes known as Folyage) is one of the fastest growing colour techniques with online mentions spiking +111% YoY. Foilyage is a similar technique to Balayage, except the hair is put in foils to seal the heat and help prevent the bleach from drying. The result? A brighter and more even blonde, making it the ideal techniques for dark brunettes.

The must have tool for any lightening service such as Foilyage is Light Master, which gives lift of up



HIGHLIGHTS

Not to be underestimated with all the new colour techniques on the block, Highlights are still the most popular method of blonding for clients. Highlights can lighten, brighten or add sun-kissed highs and lows in hair.


These are the 2019 buzzwords to know about in blonding...



This on-trend technique sees 2.7m online mentions each year, so it's worth knowing about. With Layage hair is sectioned and splayed onto a flat board so the colourist can paint the colour onto strands using a delicate brush - the result is a merged, gradient effect.

UMBRE

Continuing with the theme of all-things-Balayage, the classic Ombre technique is still in demand with more than 1.3m online mentions each year. Ombre is the gradual blending of one colour to another, usually moving tints and shades from dark through to light.




KOOT SMUDGE

Say hello to one of the hottest colour trends right now. With online searches growing at +125%yoy. A Root Smudge is the subtle way to conceal and delay root outgrowth for clients who want to stretch out their salon appointments for longer. It's also an on-trend transition for a scalp bleach client who want to take a break.



Balayage is a trend that's never going away but there are so many bespoke variations you can get creative with now. I used my signature zig-zag technique for this look. My top tip is always blend blend blend your balayage - and tone to perfection."

ROOT SMUDGE: "One of my favourite colour styles right now. For me, it's the most natural-looking colour technique and it worked so perfectly as our model wanted that worn-in California vibe. I balayaged first to create the right lift and then root smudged when it came to toning. My top tip is to get your hands thoroughly dirty with blending and always apply the lighter colour and then blend down the darker one."

FOILYAGE: "A very of-the-moment technique and trend. Foliage is perfect when you want to get that ultimate lift out of your balayage. We worked weaved sections into foils/Visi Color/Paper Not Foil throughout the head to really give impact to that blonde look. My top tip is combine foilyage with traditional balayage for gorgeous variations of depth."

Blonding

Q: What's the benefit of modern-day blonding techniques?

A: The real beauty of techniques like root smudge and foilyage is that they're all about enhancing natural beauty. Clients love them because these kind of subtle colour techniques make them look like the best version of themselves.

Q: What's your current favourite blonding technique and why?

A: A power balayage. I love working with power lines in my balayage at the moment and, tellingly, it's the most requested technique in my courses. It's all about that 90s chunky highlight, but executed in a softer and chicer way.

Q: Ombre to sombre: why is there so much variation with lightening techniques?

There's always going to be variations of one trend and the balayage trend especially has so many variations. It's mainly because us colourists like to mix it up and not get bored, but also when one trend sticks each season we need to see a variation of that technique happening. That way there's something to suit every client.

Q: How can a colourist go about guiding their client to the right lightening technique for them?

It's all about the consultation. Getting to really understand what they want from their colour, but also what's possible when you take their hair and natural tone into consideration. I always check their skin tone and eye colour, not just for suitability, but mainly to understand our limitations. I always ask how they wear their hair too - whether they wear it mainly down or up a lot - because that can be a factor for the blonding techniques I go with in the end.

Q: What's the trickiest blonding technique to get right and why? It has to be full head lightening. Because you're lifting everything, you

can end up with so many different bands if it's not done perfectly.

Q: Which celebrities are working clever lightening techniques right now?

Chloë Moretz has the most gorgeous highlighted blonde - it's supernatural but with that pop of creamy blonde to give it enhancement. Drew Barrymore's current balayage is also stunning. It has a root smudge to it so the blonde looks even lighter and contrasts beautifully with the rest of the colour.

Q: The root smudge is big news right now?

Yes, the root smudge is so on point because it really enhances the rest of the hair colour. It's all about the 90s this season and that grunge feel is definitely coming through - but in a chicer way. Deepening the roots makes the colour look more natural, but also makes the blonde look blonder.

Q: What's the best way for a brunette to lighten up with today's blonding techniques?

Foilyage is amazing for brunettes and darker bases because you really get that extra pop of lift. I also love the deeper smoky root trend as most brunettes still need depth for their skin tone, so keeping a rich root really works for that.

Q: What's your top tip for a client considering a blonding technique?

Understand what your hair is capable of. These techniques always look best when the hair is really healthy. It's also important to get a face frame that works with your features, whether you want to enhance your eyes or show off your cheekbones.

Q: Tell us about your ultimate balayage toolkit...

100%, the clay-based additive (Light Master Freehand Additive hair lightener) is my go-to balayage tool. The new ColorSync Sheer Acidic Toners are amazing too because they don't lift the natural hair and break the base of it so you can keep the hair cooler, which is a real trend at the moment.







Q: Tell us about Hair at Porters salon journey?

We started our journey in a small salon over 21 years ago, with only a few team members. With drive, hard work and motivation we were able to expand our team and premises to where we are now. This expansion allowed us to offer a more bespoke service, where customer experience became a priority. For us, it's all about making each client's first visit unforgettable so they want to come back again and again.

Q: How would you describe your salon client and what they usually want from their blonding/lightening service?

We find our clients want to achieve a classy, natural type of blonding. We tend to focus a lot of our techniques on foilyages and melted root smudges to achieve this - both of which are enhanced using Matrix ColorSync to create a beautiful gloss finish.

Q: What would you say is especially popular in blonding/lightening techniques at the moment?

For us, the most popular blonding techniques are balayages, using freehand colour placement. Instagram and celebrity influences drive the demand for blonding, as we find many people prefer a more natural look which this technique can really achieve.

Q: How have you seen blonding/ lightening evolve over the last few years?

Colour education has now become advanced

and much more accessible over the past few years. This has allowed blonding techniques to evolve from traditional cap highlights to modern freehand balayages, which our clients love.

Q: What blonding/lightening technique excites you the most and why?

The blonding technique which excites our colour team most is backcombing balayages. However, we do still love the results of a clean full head lift and tone.

Q: What celebrities tend to be most cited as inspiration for blonding/lightening techniques with clients right now?

It's often Holly Willoughby and Taylor Swift.

Q: Are you increasingly seeing brunettes requesting lightening services, like foilyage and balayage?

Yes, we're finding brunettes want to cool down their tone, as they don't like to see brassy tones in their hair. The Matrix Brass Off range is absolutely perfect for home care and maintenance. Social media has a huge impact on client's choices, especially since the new wave of grey/cool tone trends. Instagram is a great tool for clients to seek out new trends or colour inspiration and we find it very useful within the salon, too.

Q: What are your salon golden rules when it comes to blonding/lightening services?

Matrix Ultim8 Bond Protecting System and oil additives are essential to protect the hair and scalp during the lightening process – that way you get crisp, blonde results. Bond

Ultim8 is definitely our salon hero product for blonding and lightening. You can also follow up with aftercare using the Total Results The Re-Bond range.

Q: Tell us about your consultation process for blonding/lightening?

We regard honesty as being a golden rule with blonding, because the client needs to know what is actually achievable. We always consider the condition of the hair that we start with and recommend the right treatment where required. We also advise that blondes are an ongoing journey that require the most care and attention - the lighter you go, the bigger the upkeep.

Q: What's your ultimate advice for colour care with blonding/lightening clients?

Always treat the hair with rebonding products to keep the hair healthy. And ensure that you do a thorough consultation to ensure that your clients are taking home the correct aftercare. For Brunettes who are lightening, Brass Off in the answer as it helps to keep unwanted orange undertones at bay. For your more traditional, light blonde client who are levels 8+, try So Silver Shampoo and the new So Silver Conditioner to keep it cool cool cool!

Q: What's your biggest piece of advice for aspiring salon owners?

Always keep your staff happy. Invest in a good educated and enthusiastic team and keep them motivated and inspired. Most of all have fun and love what you do!
